Action Taken Report 2021-22

(1) Academic activities:

- Academic lectures were organized by almost all departments which have PG classes. Department of Political Science, invited Prof Yatindra Singh Sisodia, Director of MPCSSR Ujjain. He delivered his lecture on Research Methodology. Dr. Saroj Goswami delivered a lecture on the topic 'Chhaya Vad aur swatantrata Sangram' and Dr. Sunil Kumar Tiwari delivered a lecture on the topic 'Swadhinta andolan aur Hindi Patrakaarita Dasha aur Disha'. These two lectures were organized by the department of Hindi. Ms Jyoti Tripathi, assistant professor of Economics, GDC Sultanpur (UP), gave a lecture on the topic 'Role of women in the rise of India 21st century'.
- **E Content:** E-Content was prepared by Dr. Chitra Prabhat & Dr. K.P. Mishra (Political Science), Dr. R.P. Singh & Dr. Santosh Kumar Singh (Physics), Dr. Rahul Kumar Maurya (Mathematics), Mr. Rajesh Sahu (Chemistry), and Dr. S.K. Bajpai (Commerce).
- **Teaching Learning using New Technology**
Teachers are using new technology like smart boards, use of PPT, Virtual Labs e.g. dissection is now done virtually with the use of audio-visual aids. More use of ICT in teaching enhances subject knowledge and increases student motivation.
- **Programs related to the NEP-2020**
Webinars, lectures and workshops were organized by various departments to create awareness among the students and teachers about recent developments in their respective fields.

(2) Development of infrastructure

Renovation of physics, chemistry, zoology and botany labs, construction of new class rooms in the first floor of commerce and arts faculty building have been completed.

(3) Plantation

To maintain the green cover of the college and to enhance it, regular plantation is carried out in the campus on all occasions and special days. The botanical garden is also maintained regularly and some teachers have also participated in the Ankur yojana of the state government.



(4) Career orientation programmes and career Planning

➤ Orientation/ Training Programmes

A Six day online training programme was organized from 13.09.2021 to 18.09.2021, on the topic 'Career Nirmaan ke Avashyak Tatv', 271 students of the college participated in this programme.

➤ Industrial Tour

➤ Educational Tour

(5) Cultural & Literary activities

As per the Higher Education Calendar, cultural & literary activities were organized throughout the year. Youth Festival, celebration of important days, birthdays of great personalities, are some of the activities organized regularly in the college.

(6) Research activities

Faculty members, who are research guides, are supervising the work of the students pursuing Ph.D under their guidance. Many newly appointed assistant professors are themselves pursuing Ph.D along with active participation in other research work like, writing research papers.

(7) Organizing Health Camp

Blood donation camp was organized by the NSS & NCC wing of the college in which blood group and hemoglobin of students was also checked by medical staff.

(8) Preparation of AQAR for the session 2020-2021

Keeping in mind the area of interest of teachers, separate chapters have been allotted to teachers for compiling data and updating information related to that chapter.

(9) Developing Sports activities
